Grand Rapids, Michigan - 4.7% - Pint - \$5
Brewed With A Complex Array
Of Malts, Grains and Hops
Gives This Light IPA A Clean Fresh Taste.

Evolution - Pine'hop'le

Salisbury, Maryland - 6.8% - Pint - \$6.0
A Tropical Take On Our IPA. Brewed With Loads Of
Pineapple Juice And Hopped To Contribute To
